## TOP KEENELAND SEPTEMBER SELLERS BY STAKES WINNERS

In the Thoroughbred industry where success can sometimes be fleeting, it is worthwhile to recognize those who have repeatedly surrounded themselves with quality.

In the auction markets, consignors have the challenging task of not only attracting quality horses to sell but also placing those individuals in the right markets to extract their highest value. Regardless of where they sell, however, no horse will bring a premium unless it possesses the goods—conformation, pedigree, and attitude.

This column focuses on quality by compiling the records of Keeneland September consignors whose offerings between 2012-14 have found the greatest success as racehorses. Since acquiring black-type winners is the collective goal of buyers, BloodHorse MarketWatch focused on two metrics—the number of black-type stakes winners offered and the percentage of black-type winners from total offered.

There are 37 consignors with horses entered in this year's Keeneland September sale that achieved 6% black-type stakes winners from yearlings offered during the 2012-14 editions of this sale.

Leading this list is Greg Goodman's Mt.
Brilliant Farm with three black-types stakes
winners from 11 offered, giving Mt. Brilliant a 27%
strike rate with black-type winners. Mt. Brilliant's
record comes with an asterisk, however, because
the consignors are listed as they appeared in each
year's catalog. The numbers for Mt. Brilliant only
reflect the 2012 sale year because in 2013-14, Mt.
Brilliant sold through Gainesway's and Lane's
End's consignments.

If those yearlings of 2013-14 are put in the mix, then Mt. Brilliant offered a total of 37 yearlings 2012-14, of which four became black-type winners, or 11% of the total offered. The lower stakes winner percentage is still high enough to place Mt. Brilliant among the top seven consignors by percentage of stakes winners offered.

The top horse sold under the Mt. Brilliant banner during 2012 was homebred Cassatt (Tapit—Justenufftime), who sold for \$300,000 as a yearling and went on to win five stakes (including the Monmouth Oaks, G3) and earned \$714,733 for Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farm. Cassatt sold as a broodmare prospect at the 2016 Fasig—Tipton Kentucky November sale for \$2.5 million to Elevage Bloodstock out of a consignment by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency.

The second-ranked consignor by percentage of stakes winners offered is Mike Barnett's Blackburn Farm, which offered 26 yearlings during the time period that included four (15%) black-type winners and two graded stakes winners. The star of the group is grade 2 winner, grade 1-placed Paid Up Subscriber (Candy Ride—Shriek) who sold for \$135,000 as a yearling in 2013 and has now earned \$862,850 to date. Paid Up Subscriber was bred by Bruce and Laurie Berenson.

Among the top consignors by number of black-type winners offered, 10 sellers offered 20 or more stakes winners during the 2012-14 window. Taylor Made Sales leads this list with 68 (5%) out of 1,268 offered, followed by Gainesway with 38 (7%), Lane's End with 33 (4%), and Paramount Sales and Select Sales each with 32 (5%) to complete the top five.
